MY 30-DAY PERSONAL REVIVAL PLAN

This is a Scripture-Based Devotional to help you awaken and deepen spiritual hunger for God, as well as to experience a spiritual revival in your walk with the Holy Spirit. You can start at any time, but I encourage you to go through a 30-day period using the Prayer Plan every day.

Study the Scripture in focus, and then, you may read the entire Chapter or a few verses before and after it. Read it aloud, meditate on it and memorize it or write it out on a post it note as the Scripture before your eyes during the day. Paste your Scripture note or card in a visible location around you.

You may choose to go through these 30 Days of Personal Revival with your spouse, a family, friend or

accountability partner. Reading FIREBRAND during this period would be of further help!

Remember to write your answers and thoughts to the Reflection Questions in your Journal. Use the thoughts shared under "Ruminate" as a focal point of your meditation throughout the day, and trust the Holy Spirit to give you new insights. Beloved, fully release your faith for an awakening in your heart!

If you miss a day in the Plan, don't be discouraged; just get back up and continue!

Day One

Read:

Psalm 27: 4, 8

“One thing I have desired of the Lord, that will I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple. When you said, “Seek My face,” my heart said to You, “Your face, Lord, I will seek.”

Request:

Precious Holy Spirit, I receive your help to make a daily practice of seeking God! I declare that my highest pursuit will always be God, and I will not tire out following after him.

In the name of Jesus, my heart is consumed with divine desire and godly yearning today, more than I have ever felt before now. I am a lover of my Father's presence and there is nowhere else that I derive as much pleasure. My confession of faith today is that as I go about my day's business, my heart will continue to think about God and his mighty ways. Amen!

Reflect:

What does it mean to seek the face of the Lord? Dwelling in God's House (Presence) need not be an infrequent event in my life, but every day. How can I carry a consciousness of God everywhere, throughout each day? What memoirs and reminders can I put around my home, office, car and space to birth new longings for God in me?

Ruminate:

What is the beauty of the Lord in this Scripture above?

Day Two

Read:

Psalm 42: 1 – 2

“As the deer pants for the water brooks, so pants my soul for You, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?”

Request:

Dear Lord, I declare my desperation for more of you today! I need more of you in my life! I need you so much that I cannot succeed at anything without your help. My life is void without you and I need you more than the air I breathe!

I confess my hunger and thirst for you. Today, my greatest need is to experience the Supernatural Life in a new way. Show me how to walk with me. Bring me into your secret place. I am not a distant observer to the life of faith, I am an insider! Thank you Holy Spirit because you hold my hands and lead me into deeper places in God.

God has become an irresistible attraction to me! God has become an insatiable longing in me! God has become an unquenchable thirst in my spirit. All parts of my inner man is awake to God! Amen.

Reflect:

What drives me into God's presence? How often do I respond to those nudging and longings?

Day Three

Read:

Psalm 63: 1 - 8

“O God, You are my God; early will I seek You; my soul thirsts for You; my flesh longs for You in a dry and thirsty land where there is no water. So I have looked for You in the sanctuary, to see Your power and Your glory. Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise You. Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name. My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness, and my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips.

When I remember You on my bed, I meditate on You in the night watches. Because You have been my help, therefore in the shadow of Your wings I will rejoice. My soul follows close behind You.”

Request:

Father, I confess that you are my God; my personal God! And in the name of Jesus, I make a culture of seeking you early. I carry such irrepressible passion to be with you and know you more; that nothing I do or become is complete without you. The pursuit of your presence is so strong on me that I cannot help my search for you!

I declare that my soul is satisfied with you and in you! The deepest parts of my human essence continually find full delight in Jesus Christ, just like the body is nourished by good food. You are my supplier of life! Precious Holy Spirit, I receive your wisdom to balance the demands in my life and make room for daily fellowship with you! Thank you for a new lease of life. Amen!

Reflect:

How can I grow in my close pursuit of God? What does it take to seek God early? How might I re-order my priorities and re-arrange my schedule to spend time quietly with the Lord? Write out five little adjustments you can make in your life to become more of a God-chaser.

Ruminate:

What did the Psalmist mean when he said “your lovingkindness is better than life”?

Read:

Psalm 84: 1 – 4, 10

“How lovely is your dwelling place, O Lord Almighty! My soul yearns, even faints, for the courts of the LORD; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God. Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may have her young — a place near your altar, O LORD Almighty, my King and my God. Blessed are those who dwell in your house; they are ever praising you. Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked”

Request:

Thank you Holy Spirit for showing me into the inner courts of God Almighty. Thank you for taking me to places I have never been in God. Thank you for giving me glimpses of glory and full views of joy! I am ready for more. I confess that everything I have ever known in the past are nothing compared to what you have started doing in my life today! Hallelujah!

I receive a desire for God so strong, that it drives me into his arms many times every day! My confident declaration is that I am on great terms with Jesus and I know the Holy Spirit intimately.

Reflect:

What does a desire for God mean? How will I know that my heart is moved, more and more for Jesus? Write out a list of things, places and people that you love deeply. What do you do to keep this

love going? How can you bring that into your Christian walk?

Ruminate:

Where is God's presence?

Read:

Psalm 62: 5 – 8

“Find rest, O my soul, in God alone; my hope comes from him. He alone is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken. My salvation and my honor depend on God; he is my mighty rock, my refuge. Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge”

Request:

Lord, I give you thanks because you alone are my God and my hope comes from you! You are my rock, my salvation and my fortress; therefore, I will not be shaken! Today, I rest in God! I absolutely rest in your love, your favor, your truth,

your wisdom and your purpose for me! I will not be moved by what my eyes see, but I fix my vision on you Lord.

Sweet Holy Spirit, I receive your help to grow my practice of trusting God with my life! I will not let my emotions override my faith but will continue to grow in faith, giving glory to God.

Reflect:

How can I deepen my assurance of faith in God? What does it mean to trust Him at all times? On a scale of 1 to 10 (1 = never, 10 = absolutely always), rate how easy it is for you to speak to God FIRST about anything going on in your life before a friend or spouse.

List a few things in your life that you have confidence in; that may not make you seek God as your first resort in daily situations (e.g. money, a good job, a loving spouse, a stable economy, good

support system, great work skills etc.)

Ruminate:

What does it mean to pour your soul out to God?

Read:

Philippians 3: 7 – 11

“But whatever was to my profit I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God and is by faith. I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead.”

Request:

Today, I declare that I experience the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus as my Lord in a personal, reviving way. The veils have been lifted and my God has caused light to shine in the face of Christ; therefore, I fully discern the ways of my heavenly Father.

In the name of Jesus, nothing will be too difficult for me to give up for the sake of knowing Christ. I receive divine light today, to see Christ in the Scriptures and for Christ to be produced in me through the hard things in my life. Amen.

Reflect:

Do I know Christ in a personal, reviving way or am I a spectator to the things of the Kingdom? What signs in my life show that I truly know Christ? How have I changed since I met Christ? Write out some things you have lost to walk with the Lord.

Ruminate:

What does it mean to gain Christ?

Read:

Isaiah 55:1-3, 6-8

“Ho, every one that thirsts, come to the waters and he that has no money; come buy and eat; yea, come buy wine and milk without money and without price. Wherefore do you spend money for that which is not bread and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Hearken diligently unto me and eat that which is good and let your soul delight itself in fatness. Incline your ear and come to me; hear and your soul shall live.

Seek the Lord while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near; let the wicked forsake his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts and let him return unto the Lord and He will have mercy upon Him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.”

Request:

I boldly declare that this is the beginning of the best years of my life. Today, I say yes to the invitations of the Holy Spirit, to come to the waters of eternal life. I declare that I buy and eat without money and price; for the Lord has given me all things that pertain to life and godliness.

I feed fat on God! I eat so fully that my spirit is fed fat and my soul is nourished! In instructions, I am established and in truth, I am preserved. I have a truly satisfying relationship with the Lord and it strengthens me to live the abundance life in Jesus name.

I receive a listening ear and humble heart to hear and heed the instructions of the Holy Spirit today. My confession of faith is that the mercy of the Lord restores me from every way I have turned back from him. He restores me to prayer and praise. Amen!

Reflect:

What does it mean to buy without money and price? Do I feel like my relationship with the Lord deeply satisfies my greatest needs? Are there needs, desires and aspirations in my life that make me chase things, rather than God or get me too busy to grow my faith? Write out some of those needs. How can I turn my desires and aspirations to the Lord?

Ruminate:

What does it mean to buy without money or price?

Oh that men would praise the Lord for his lovingkindness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! For He satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul He fills with good.”

Request:

Lord, you are my God and my help in affliction! Today, I rejoice in your ability to save me from trouble and restore my faint soul. My heart will no longer be worn out by things too strong for me and I will not be too weak to seek the Lord.

I declare that the Lord has satisfied my longing and fulfilled his promise to me. My eyes see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living, and I praise him with joyful lips. I declare that the Holy Spirit leads me into my own city and place of destiny; therefore, I no longer roam in desert experiences. Hallelujah!

As I rise out of the dark places, I come into the light and return in love to the Lord.

Reflect:

Are there desert experiences, repetitions and wanderings in my life that show me that I may be far from the Lord? What are these? Am I tired in my heart because I have been running helter skelter – trying to sort myself out on my own? What's stressing me out in my life right now and what is the Spirit saying to me about these issues?

Ruminate:

How does God lead men?

Revelations 22:1, 17

Request:

What am I really thirsty for? Do I know how to drink deeply when I come to the river of life? Make a list of your spiritual desires and the kind of believer you want to mature into – you may call these your spiritual goals.

Ruminate:

“On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. He who believes in me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.” But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive;”

Whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.”

Request:

Thank you for this tenth day of my walk into spiritual hunger. Thank you Lord for you are awakening and alerting me to yourself. Thank you for setting your thoughts in my heart! Thank you for releasing fountains into my spirit man! Thank you for showing me the path of life again!

Psalm 36:7-9

For with you is the fountain of life: in your light shall we see light.”

Request:

Today, I thank you Lord for your mercies in my life and rejoice for the shadow of your wings – the place I hide and I’m safe! Oh glory to God! I

declare by faith that the presence of the Lord will produce the fullness of God in me, and as I come to the place of prayer, I am always touched and transformed. Amen!

I declare that my prayer experience is dry, dim or dead. I do not come into my Father's presence as a mere religious routine but I come for breathtaking encounters that leaves me in awe of God every time! Today, I receive secrets of the secret place; the fatness of God's presence and the best gifts that come with spending time with the Lord. Hallelujah.

In the name of Jesus, I receive new eyes to see and a heart that will not become so familiar with the things of the Spirit that I no longer discern his ways. Thank Jesus for light that comes from the Light of God. Amen!

Reflect:

What thoughts do I associate with being in the presence of God? Write honestly the thoughts that come to your mind when you think about the place of prayer. Request:

Thank you for the end-time harvest Lord Jesus! Thank you for the final hour, and all that you’re doing! I receive my portion in your work. I receive

my memorial and tribute in your assignment. I receive a pressing passion for the work and will of God; that I find myself constantly seeking the fulfilment of God's purpose on earth.

Precious Holy Spirit, I receive revelation knowledge; therefore, I fully understand my earthly work and what you are accomplishing in the nations. I receive a burden and urgency of the Kingdom Agenda.

I declare that God's work in the church, families, systems, institutions, society and government will be stronger in my heart than any other need in my life. Amen.

Reflect:

What is my role in God's final work on earth? In my own little ways, how can I contribute to the purpose of Christ as he reconciles the world to himself? What can I do in my community, local

assembly, amongst family members, through ministry, in my marriage, while raising my children or doing business – to make Christ known and glorified.

Is my work effective in my church? Am I moving with passionate urgency with the assignment that God has given to me? What must I do today to put things right?

Ruminate:

What is the Will and Work of God?

“The poor and needy seek water and there is none and their tongue fails for thirst. I, the lord will answer them, I the God of Israel, will not forsake them. I will open rivers on the bare heights and fountains in the midst of the valleys; I will make the wilderness a pool of water and the dry land springs of water.”

Request:

Today, I ask for a restoration of my spiritual fervency, fervor and fire! I declare that my heart is filled again with an overwhelming sense of

commitment and covenant to God. Sweet Holy Spirit, I receive your outpouring of the rivers of presence into all parts of my life and experiences – both the high points and low places! Amen.

Study the Scripture in focus, and then, you may read the entire Chapter or a few verses before and after it. Read it aloud, meditate on it and memorize it or write it out on a post it note as the Scripture before your eyes during the day. Paste your post it note in a visible location around you.

“The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name sake”

Request:

Dear Lord, help me always to know and remember that you are shepherd. In you I lack nothing and in you I have everything.

I declare that I trust you with my life. I trust you to lead me and guide me. Lord I follow you as you lead me to walk in your ways and as you draw me to stay close to you. Amen

In the name Jesus my soul is refreshed, and restored. Help me rest in your Grace and in the confidence that you are always with me. Amen

Reflect:

What does it mean to you for God to be your Shepherd? Do you trust in God to lead you and to guide into righteousness? Are you hungry for God's leadership or do you only run to him when you're weary from trying to do it on your own?

Think now on one area of your life where you feel like you always go off on your own, like a sheep without a shepherd. How can you begin to desperately desire God's leading and trusting him to guide you?

Day Sixteen

Read:

John 4: 31 – 40

“If I bear witness of Myself, My witness is not true. There is another who bears witness of Me, and I know that the witness which He witnesses of Me is true. You have sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth. Yet I do not receive testimony from man, but I say these things that you may be saved.

He was the burning and shining lamp, and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his light. But

I have a greater witness than John’s; for the works which the Father has given Me to finish—the very works that I do—bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me. And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.

But you do not have His word abiding in you, because whom He sent, Him you do not believe. You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.”

Request:

In the name of Jesus, I declare that the Holy Spirit bears witness of Christ in my heart, the witness of Christ remains in me and my heart is grounded in truth. The Holy Spirit shows me and teaches me till I understand, the work that my Heavenly Father has given to me to finish so that I might do them! I will not be slack concerning the mandate that is heavy upon my spirit, but I am awake unto my responsibility. Amen!

Today, I boldly declare my faith in Jesus Christ, and I am a believer whose praise is in the gospel! As I study the Scriptures, my confident confession

is that I find eternal life in them and I see Jesus revealed today. Glory to God!

Reflect:

Do I believe the witness of a man about Christ than I believe the witness of Christ about himself? Which words weigh stronger in my heart – the ones I hear from my pastor and read from the book of my favorite author or the words Christ speaks to me from the pages of the Scripture?

What do I really believe? What are my godly convictions and creed of faith? If my unsaved friend asks me “why are you born again?”, what would my response be?

Ruminate:

The Father testified about Jesus Christ. How does the Father testify about a believer?
